Q.1 What does the word 'Medieval' mean in History?

Answer

The period that lies between the ancient and modern periods of history is known as the middle or Medieval period.

Q.2 In how many parts Medieval period has been divided?

Answer

The Medieval history has been divided into two parts:

Early Medieval period

The early Medieval period dates from the 8th century to the 13th century, i.e., between 700 and 1200 CE.

Late Medieval period

The Late Medieval period dates from the 13th century to the 18th century, i.e. from 1200 to 1750 CE.

Q.3 What are the two main sources of Medieval history?

**Answer** 

Two main sources of Medieval history are :-

- (a) Archeological sources
- (b) Literary Sources

Literary sources. The sources that are present in the form of written documents are known as the Literary Sources. They tell us about the life of the people, the administration and military exploits.

## Archeological sources

In archeological sources Temples, forts, art objects like paintings and Sculptures, inscriptions and coins; tools, utensils, ornaments and jewels are included.
